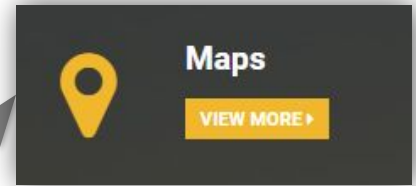


How to Make a Map in All Things Missouri

1. From the homepage, click on the “Maps” button or scroll down and choose a starter map, or build your own in the “Missouri Map Room”.

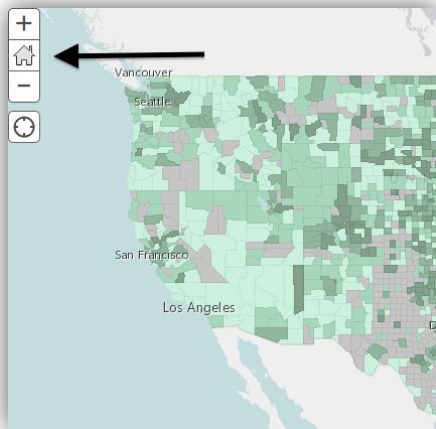
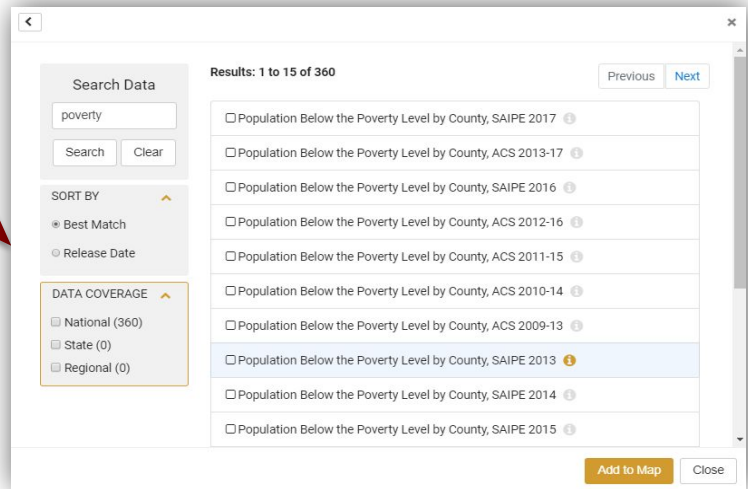


2. Add data to your map by typing in a keyword or explore all data by clicking the “Browse by Topic” or Browse by Source buttons.
