



ALL THINGS MISSOURI HOW TO BUILD A MAP

The All Things Missouri Map Room allows you to create customized maps by county, ZIP code, census tract, and more. The Missouri Map Room includes nearly 30,000 data layers from hundreds of reliable secondary sources.



STEP THREE: Zoom into your community by clicking the plus and minus buttons at the top left of the map window or enter a location name in the search bar at the top right of the map window. Click anywhere on the map to get more information.







STEP FOUR: Add additional layers to your map by clicking the "Add Data" button at the top left corner of the map window and repeating the instructions from STEP TWO.
